What is POSITIVE BEHAVIOR INTERVENTION SUPPORT (PBIS) all about?

There are 4 levels of PBIS:

- 1. School-wide
- 2. Classroom
- <mark>3. Targeted</mark>
- Individual Student


1. <u>School-wide/Universal/Green Level</u>: Processes and procedures intended for all students and staff, in all settings across campus. This level of School-Wide Positive Behavior Support (SWPBIS) is intended to impact approximately 80% of all students and staff

2. <u>Classroom</u>: Processes and procedures that reflect school-wide expectations for student behavior coupled with pre-planned strategies applied with classroom settings

3. <u>Targeted Group/Secondary/Yellow Level</u>: Processes and procedures designed to address behavioral issues of groups of students with similar behavior problems or behaviors that seem to occur for the same reason (attention seeking, escape) and/or across similar settings

4. <u>Individual Student/Tertiary/Red Level</u>: Processes and procedures that reflect schoolwide expectations for student behavior coupled with team-based strategies to address problematic behaviors of individual students

School-Wide Positive Behavior Support

- Central Middle School has implemented a system of teaching all students school-wide procedures and rewarding them with incentives known as *PBIS*.
- > PBIS is a broad range of systemic and individualized strategies for achieving important social and learning outcomes while preventing problem behavior with all students.
